A native of Mexico City, Carla began her career working as an analyst with Skandia, a Mexican financial institution, where she worked directly with the Operations Manager to gain an understanding of the Mexican financial system and diversified investment fund portfolios.

Carla went on to gain significant experience in business development and finance at Abilia S.A. de C.V., a leading Mexican private equity firm, where she negotiated new ventures with landowners and private equity investors. Carla led the financial evaluation of numerous potential real estate projects, six of which (valued at more than U.S. \$500MM) were ultimately approved by the investment committee.

Carla's additional accomplishments with Abilia S.A. de C.V. included the creation of a new financial case model for private equity projects increasing the Internal Rate of Return (IRR) by 4.6 points, participation in the underwriting of two major projects in Mexico City (placing over U.S. \$300MM), and researching, designing, and proposing new business plans in renewable energy.
